This presentation tells the story of MassMen, a statewide health promotions campaign funded by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health to help address the mental, emotional, and relational needs of men 25-64.

Franklin Cook, Director of Community Outreach for MassMen, will share how an increase in suicide among men in the commonwealth prompted the creation of this online campaign in partnership with Screening for Mental Health and community prevention coalitions across Massachusetts.
